

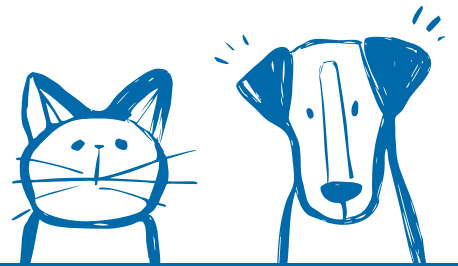


## URGENT CARE (MVUCS)

Anal gland issues, back pain, coughing or sneezing (CAT), coughing (DOG) – with no likelihood of being contagious, ear infection, euthanasia, facial swelling, fever, frequent or urgent urination (+/- blood in the urine), intestinal parasites, itching, skin rashes, lameness or limping, loss of appetite, lumps and bumps, mild constipation or straining to defecate, minor bite wounds, lacerations, ocular discharge or squinting, post-operative incision issues, single seizure event, skin abscesses, torn or bleeding nail, vaccine or allergic reactions with facial swelling or hives, vomiting or diarrhea.

## EMERGENCY/CRITICAL CARE (MVA)

Anemia, Coughing or Sneezing (DOG) with the possibility of being contagious, difficulty or labored breathing, euthanasia, Infectious condition, heat stroke, kidney failure, multiple failure (clusters), pneumonia, severe bite wounds or lacerations, severe lethargy, sudden collapse or paralysis, toxins, unproductively straining to urinate, vehicular trauma (hit by car).
