SURGERY AT MVUCS

Difficult surgical cases may be best managed by a specialist. Possessing the instruction, expertise, and equipment to perform the most demanding procedures, a residency trained surgeon can help the family veterinarian provide the best possible care to the patient. Rapid advances in the veterinary profession can make it difficult for veterinarians to remain current with recent developments in techniques and technologies required to manage some of today's complex surgical problems.

While performing a range of different procedures, the surgery department at MVUCS focuses on minimal invasive surgeries including arthroscopy/orthopedics and laparoscopy (gastropexy, liver biopsy, and spay procedures).

Drop-off orthopedic examinations are offered at MVUCS for the busy pet parent. Drop off your pet before going to work. A surgeon will examine your pet, speak with you on the phone, and perform diagnostics as needed prior to you collecting your pet at the end of the day.
